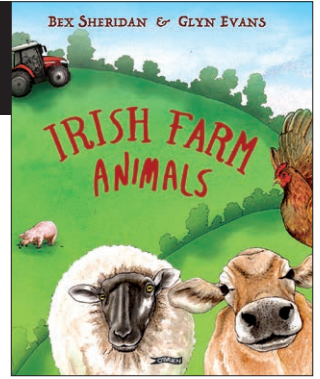


Woolly Jumpers Pages 22-27
