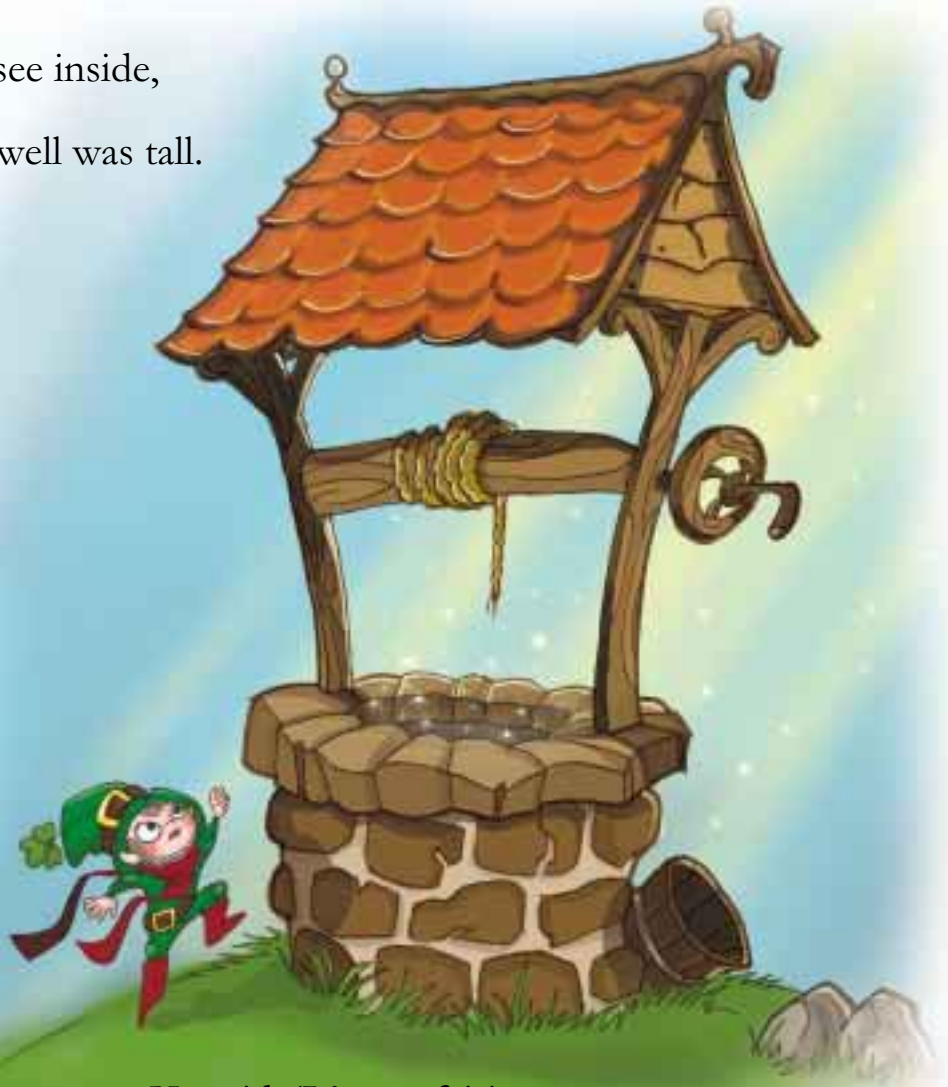


He ran across the meadow,
