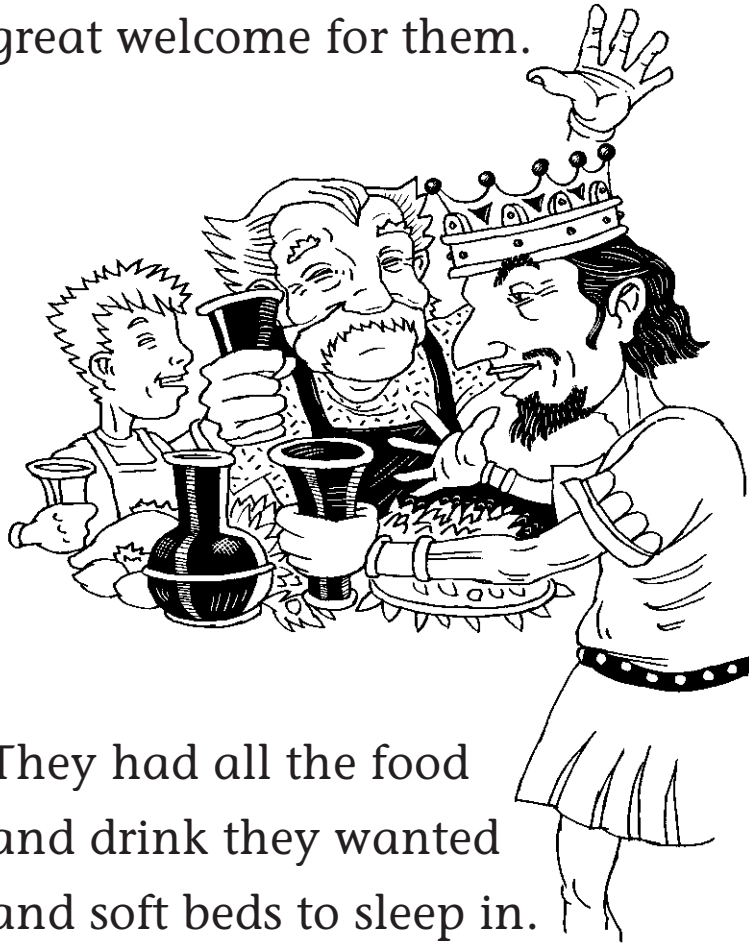
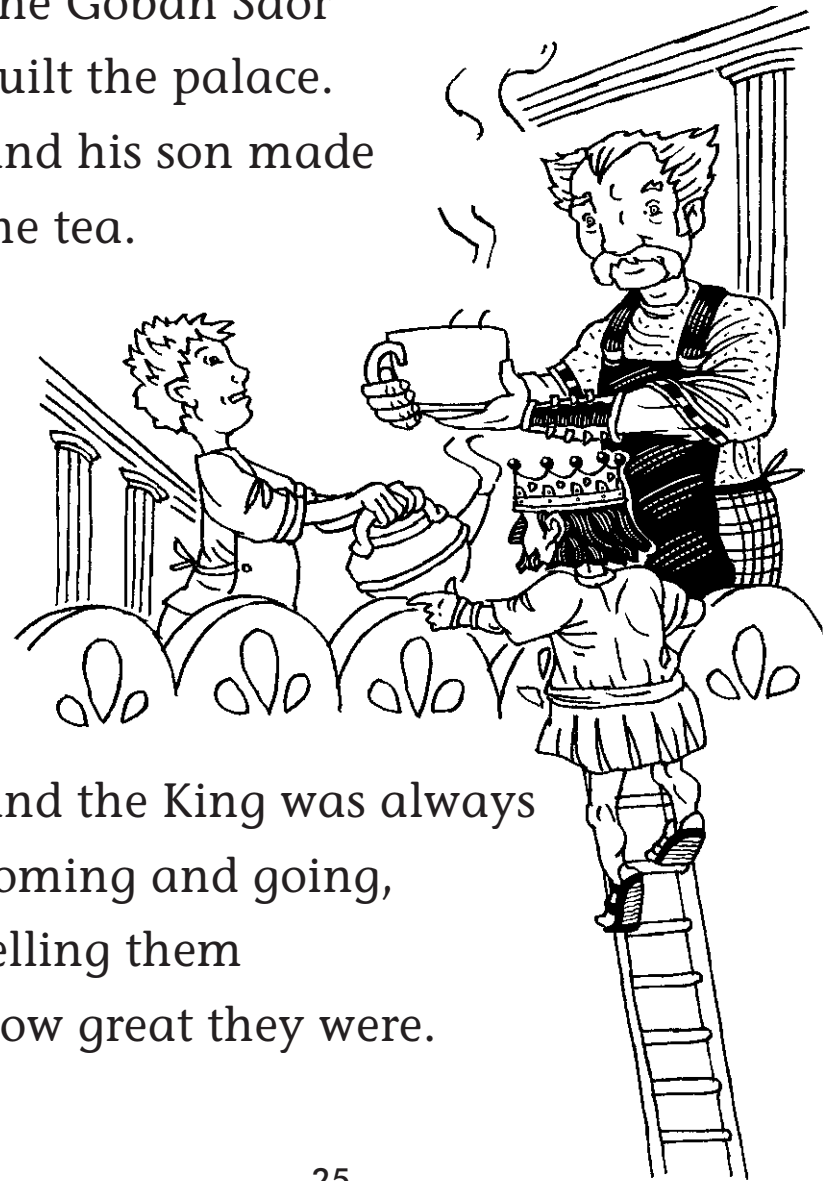


When they got there
